Making and Animating a Plasma Tube

With that done it's time to set up the animation render.
Select the RadioCity tool. **(pic. 96)**



And click in the window anywhere.

On the RadioCity menu render tab select which camera to use, (front camera to use another camera you'll need to adjust the scene for that camera) set up the size or dimensions (in pixel) you what the animation to be. Then select animation from the Output pull down menu. **(pic. 97)**

On the Animation tab set the start time to 0.000 and the end time to 3.000
You can change the FPS to more or less which will make the animation smoother (more) or jumpier (less)

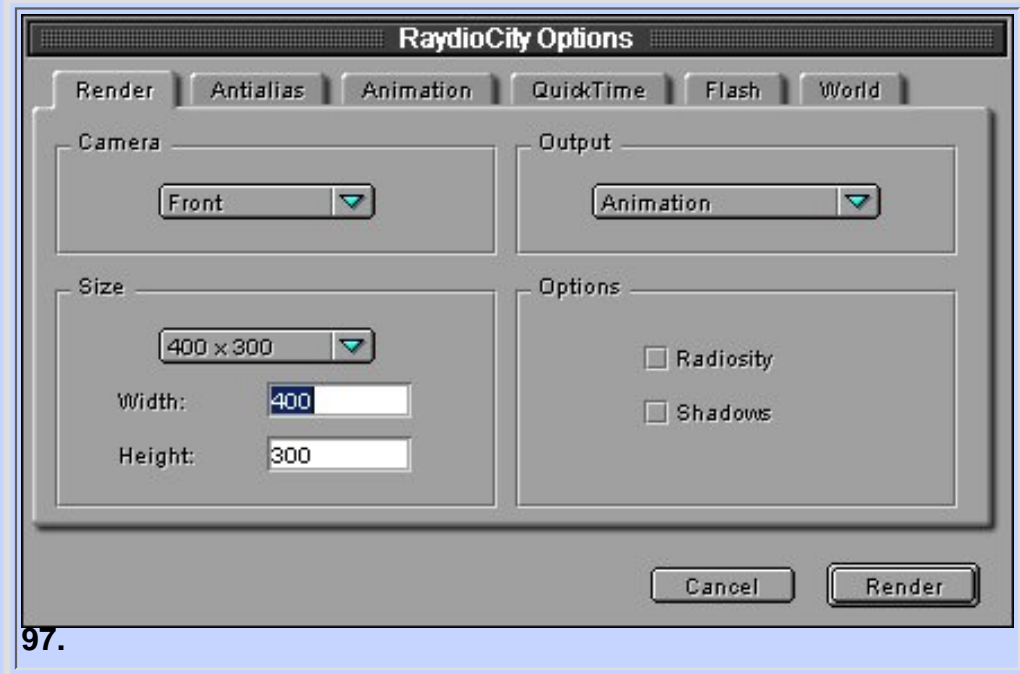
This will also effect the file size of the animation. **(pic. 98)**

On the Quick Time tab select a format type and compression setting. The compression setting will effect the quality and also the file size. If you what to render to the swf format (flash) you will need to set that up on the render tab output pull down menu then set up the flash properties on the Flash tab. **(pic. 99)**

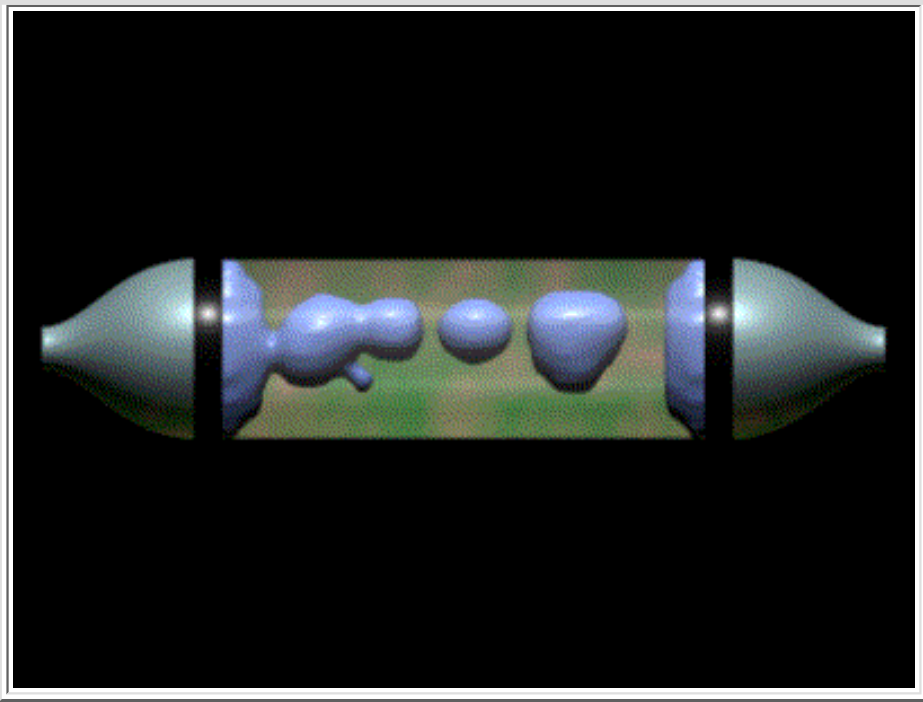
Once the animation is set up hit the Render button and you will be ask to save and name the animation.

After that the render process will start. **(pic. 100)**

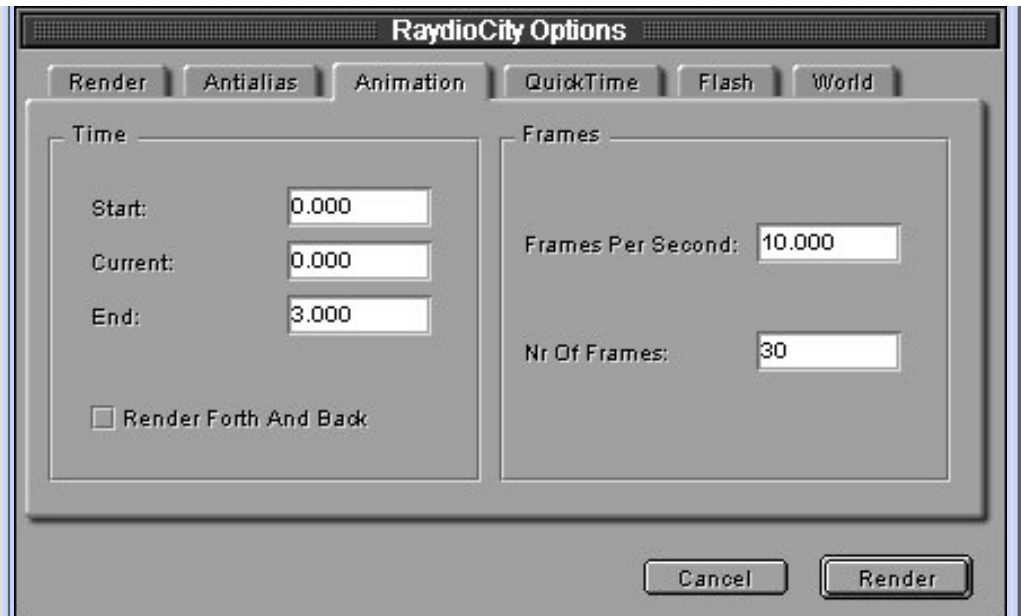
